Thousands of men and women have died in work zones over the years, including workers, motorists, pedestrians, law enforcement officers, public safety officials and children.

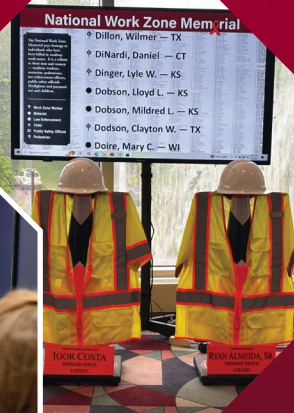

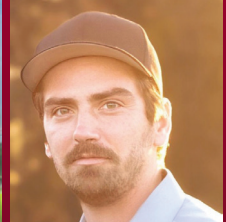
